Here are some updates on the actions, advocacy and activities that I am doing on behalf the disability

community. First, the IAS project is coming to an end for the 30 participants. Currently we are working on the final report, to ensure that the support stays in place after the project ends. Please keep an eye out for a media and public campaign in late fall to celebrate this project, and recommendations that come from it.

Second, I am looking for Members and families that have had or are having hard time getting an accessible childcare spot. I am working with Manitoba Advocate for Children and Youth on building a case of discrimination. Please let me know if you are able to share your experience.

Third, I am looking for Members that are having a hard time accessing mental health resources from the Government of Manitoba. Please let me know if you are able to share your experience.

Fourth, there has been a change with getting transportation vouchers for social trips from the Department of Families. If this change has affected you or your family member, please let me know.

CPMB is advocating that the Department change their policy and make it easier to get out into the community. We need your story, so please share if you are able.


